GENERAL INFORMATION

The **Doctor Agon Open Series Female CS:GO** is a tournament of the videogame Counter-Strike: Global Offensive, organized by Hyped, Ltd, with the support of **Doctor Agon**. The players should have the consideration that by signing up, they can qualify, and by that, will have to play the Grand Final, which will be at **6th of December**.

1. INFORMATION

1.1. Format and Date

1.1.1. Qualification #1 (ONLINE) - Open Qualifier 28th November 2020 - ([LINK](#))

- 28th of November: Starting at 15H00 (WEST);

1.1.2. Qualification #2 (ONLINE) - Open Qualifier 29th November 2020 – ([LINK](#))

- 29th of November: Starting at 15H00 (WEST);

1.1.3. Final Four

6th of December

FORMAT: Single Elimination BO3 - Top 4 from Open Qualifiers (2 in Each)

1.2. Number of Participants

1.2.1. Open Qualifiers: Without a limit (minimum 8 teams for the tournament to take place).

1.2.2. Final Four: 4 Teams (Top 2 of Each Open Qualifier)

1.3. Prize-Pool

The prize-pool distribution will be as followed:

- 1st Place – 300€
- 2nd Place – 100€
- 3rd/4th Place - 50€

After the tournament final, the winning teams will be contacted by Hyped, Ltd. The prize-pool distribution is subjected to the emission of invoice by the teams, with the legal tax in Portugal. After receiving the invoice, the prizes are paid until 90 days from that.

1.4. Registration

Attention: The lack of one of this steps can lead to the disqualification of the team, and by that, the impossibility of participation:

- a. The players, captain or team manager have to fill every required information on the Qualifier Platform, FaceIT. In the tournament day, they will have to Check-In, the hour before the tournament.
- b. After qualifying from the Open Qualifiers, the four teams will have to fill a form, that will be given by the Administration. This form is required and the information is private and secured. If needed, the team can contact the Administration by the following: [discord](#) and [email](#).
- c. Any intention of changing the initial registration on FaceIT (Players, new registrations, nicknames, etc..) should be by the players, captain or Team Manager, before the tournament, on the platform FaceIT.
- d. This is a female only tournament, so all the players HAVE to be female. ID Confirmation can be asked and in case of confirmation, the players will have to proof they are female.

* Schedule by reference .The schedule is merely informative, the games being ASAP – As soon as possible.

2. General Rules

2.1. Players

The players are everyone that made part of a team competing in the tournament, being players, subs or even Coaches/Team Managers. The players have to:

- 2.1.1. Being respectful to the Administration, other players and spectators. They should, too, have good sportsmanship, during all phases of the tournament.
- 2.1.2. Be ready to start the games at the designated time.
- 2.1.3. Have a CS:GO and FaceIT account, that is eligible to play.
- 2.1.4. A player can only have one team, during this tournament.

2.2. Teams

- 2.2.1. The teams need to have, a minimum, of 5 players.
- 2.2.2. Have, at maximum, of 2 subs (Not required, but in case of the team can't use the 5 initial players, they can get disqualified – In case of wanting to sign in subs, after the qualifying phase, they should do it by e-mail.
- 2.2.3. You can have 1 Coach by team.
- 2.2.4. In case of warning the Administration and getting authorized, the team can do changes between phases, on the following points:
 - 2.2.4.1. Registration of players, if the team doesn't have the maximum authorized – 7 Players. The players have to be Free Agents – Not being on another team in the tournament.
 - 2.2.4.2. Replacing players, that doesn't do a bigger change than 50% of the initial players.
 - 2.2.4.3. Changing Team Name or Team Logo.

2.3. Team Captain

- 2.3.1. Every team has to decide a captain, being the Player that have the responsibility to:
 - Making the communication between team and Administration.
 - Making the communication between team and other teams.

2.4. Eligibility to participate:

- 2.4.1. To participate in this tournament, all players need to be female gender with an id (citizen id card, drivers license or passport) that states so.
- 2.4.2. The players can't have a prohibition of VALVE, STEAM or FaceIT.
- 2.4.3. The players can't have a job contract (Temporary or effective) with VALVE or the Administration.
- 2.4.4. The players can't be from the Administration.
- 2.4.5. The teams have to have a minimum of 5 Players.

Note: If any team make a registration with a non-female player, they will get disqualified and can have more consequences, like a ban duration of Hyped's tournaments.

2.5. Game Conducts:

- 2.5.1. It's forbidden to use bugs and/or exploits in the game, in a way to have an advantage on the opponents.
- 2.5.2. It's forbidden to use any type of hacks, being in-game or out of the game.
- 2.5.3. Account-sharing it's forbidden (more than one player in each account).
- 2.5.4. The teams can use to three (3) tactical timeouts, 60 seconds each, by map.

3. TOURNAMENT

3.1. Open Qualification Phase

3.1.1. The Open Qualification Phase will be in a Single Elimination, Bo1, format.

3.1.2. A knife round is made, at the beginning of each map, in a way of knowing in what side each team starts.

3.1.3. It's required to use the FaceIT Anti-Cheat.

3.1.4. There will be 2 Winners in Each Qualifier. Both those teams (4 in Total) will play the Final Phase –Final Four.

3.1.5. Maps:

De_vertigo; De_dust2; De_inferno; De_nuke; De_mirage; De_train; De_overpass.

3.2. Final Four

3.2.1. The rules of the Open Qualification Phase still apply in this phase, unless if the things said after this will be contrary to that.

3.2.2. The Final Four will be composed by 4 teams from the Open Qualification Phase.

3.2.3. The format will be of Single Elimination BO3.

3.3. Map Veto

3.3.1. For every Bo1 Game:

- Initial team will be randomize on FaceIT | On the Final Four will be the Upper Team;
- Team A bans 1 map;
- Team B bans 1 map;
- Team A bans 1 map;
- Team B bans 1 map;
- Team A bans 1 map;
- Team B bans 1 map;
- The last map will be the chosen map;

3.3.2. For every Bo3 Game:

- Team A bans 1 map;
- Team B bans 1 map;
- Team A chooses 1 map, being the 1st Map;
- Team B chooses 1 map, being the 2nd Map;
- Team A bans 1 map;
- Team B bans 1 map;
- The last map will be the 3rd Map, in case of tie in the first two maps;

3.3.3. Server Settings:

- Knife round is made on the start of each map, where the winner chooses which side to start.
- Round time = 1.55 minutes;
- Freeze time = 15 seconds;
- Buy-Time = 20 seconds;
- Bomb time = 40 seconds;

3.3.4. Overtime Settings:

- Bo3;
- Money = 16 000;
- (...) The rest of the configurations are according to FaceIT.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Qualification Phase

- 4.1.1. The schedule will be available on the Administration Discord (LINK) and on FaceIT. The games will be ASAP, unless stated otherwise by the administration.
- 4.1.2. The players should be on the match room, 10 minutes before the game.
- 4.1.3. In case of both teams, and the administration, want to start the game before the suggested schedule, you can start the game before. In case of not having authorization of the three parties, the initial time will be the final time and there is a 10 minutes tolerance.
- 4.1.4. The teams have to consider that the games can start before or after the initial time, if the games before will delay or end before the time.

4.2. Final Four

- 4.2.1. The schedule is final and there can't have changes, unless there is a urgent situation.
- 4.2.2. A team should be ready to play as soon as the Administration asks.
- 4.2.3. The teams have to consider that the games can start before or after the initial time, if the games before will delay or end before the time.

5. SPORTSMANSHIP

- 5.1. Every players should be respectful of the rules and have to show sportsmanship in all parts of the tournament.
- 5.2. It's extremely forbidden any type of comment/behavior anti-sportsmanship, racist, xenophobic, offensive, etc.. that can destroy or affect someone well-being. This is a sensitive subject and using this type of comments/behaviors, to gain advantage or just using it, can lead to a disqualification.

6. NOTES AND CONDUCTS

- 6.1. The data given by the players will be only available to the Administration.
- 6.2. By registering on the tournament the players are giving authorization for free use of image to the administration.
- 6.3. If participating on the tournament, all the rules are agreed to and can't be taken after.
- 6.4. The administration reserves the right to change any rules, without any warning in any taken moment.
- 6.5. Any type of disrespect or offensive comments/behavior to the administration, players or spectators, can be punished with the disqualification.
- 6.6. All streaming rights belongs to the Administration. A team can't say they don't want to get streamed.
- 6.7. It's forbidden to stream the Qualifiers or Final Four, by any entity, team, player or spectator, without the Administration authorization. If there is a non-authorized stream, you can get punished.
- 6.8. The administration is superior in every decision.

7. WARNING

- 7.1. Tournament Administration and Organization reserves the right to change and apply any new rules during the duration of the Tournament. This type of action includes, but is not limited to: software updates, decisions about the functioning of the stream, the competition or any tertiary activity that may occur organized by the administration during the competition. It also includes any type of penalty that the organization decides to apply based on good sense and good performance of the competition, even if it did not specify or foresee the problem in question and the penalty applied. Participants are asked to carefully read the entire regulation and to understand that, rather than rules, this text serves as a guideline to ensure fair play and the smooth running of the tournament so, in extreme cases, the organization reserves the right to deviate or increase these rules.
